I recommend that you use the flashcards under the "Learn" mode because it uses a method called "Spaced Repetition" that will keep the vocabulary in your long term memory. Go into the settings and choose to answer in both Spanish and English. Make sure that you are honest with yourself and click the *I did know* or the *I didn't know*. You will only be hurting yourself if you "lie" and the word will not be stored in your long term memory.

On the next page you will find a table that lists all of the summer vocabulary words in case you rather study a different way.

Your summer work for Spanish III H is to memorize the vocabulary words and infinitives in the Quizlet set. You will have a quiz on this information during the first week of school. Quizzes in my class are worth 35% of your overall grade. I will pick 30 random vocabulary words from the Quizlet set that are in English and you will have to write the Spanish translation. I will then pick a different random 30 vocabulary terms from the Quizlet set that are in Spanish and you will need to write the English translation. In total you will be tested on 60 terms.

During the rest of the month of August, we will be reviewing the present, preterite, and imperfect. You will get quizzed on these tenses and quizzes are worth 35% of your final grade. I suggest that you review these topics on your own during the summer as well because we will be reviewing the tenses at a faster pace.
